

Council Minutes  
October 14, 2008 - 8:00 a.m.  
Special Called Meeting

The Pinson City Council met in special called session in Council Chambers at 6230 Dry Creek Lane on Tuesday, October 14, 2008. Mayor Sanders called the meeting to order and dispensed with the invocation and the pledge of allegiance.

**Committee Reports:**

**Finance:** Councilor Tanner made a motion to pay the Election Officials in the amount of \$975.00. Councilor Cochran duly seconded the motion. Mayor Sanders called for any discussion. As there was no discussion Mayor Sanders called for all opposed say “no”, all in favor say “aye.” Mayor Sanders said “Let the record reflect that the motion passed unanimously”.

**New Business:** Councilor Churchwell offered a resolution for canvassing election results. Councilor McCain duly seconded the motion. Mayor Sanders announced that the result of the election was:

Shane Shelnutt – 176

David Meadows – 149

Mayor Sanders added that there were no provisional ballots cast and the totals have been certified by the tapes you all have a copy of.

Mayor Sanders called for any discussion. As there was no discussion Mayor Sanders called for a roll call vote with the following results: Mayor Sanders-yes; Councilor Tanner-yes; Councilor Cochran-yes; Councilor Churchwell-yes; Councilor McCain-yes.

**Mayor Sanders, resolution adopted unanimously, as Resolution number 08-32.**

Mayor Sanders stated that in April Commissioner Collins had mentioned to him that perhaps there would be some left over Block Grant or Community Grant money. At that time we were looking at a Sound System at around \$6,000-\$7,000 and a pick up truck. Mayor Sanders made a request as allowed and had discounted receiving the grant because

of the things going on with the Commission. Mayor Sanders saw Commissioner Collins at the Turkey Creek Preserve dedication and she stated that the grant money had been approved. In addition there may be some other Public Safety opportunities through Center Point Fire, selling items this winter. Mayor Sanders stated that \$6,000 would be directed toward the sound system and \$3,000 would be directed toward a vehicle. Mayor Sanders suggest that we go forward and accept the grant.

Councilor Churchwell asked that council hold a work session on October 30<sup>th</sup>, to discuss several items pertaining to the new council chambers, etc. Mayor Sanders stated that if that would work for everyone then the work session would be scheduled for October 30<sup>th</sup>.

Councilor Cochran moved to adjourn. Councilor Churchwell duly seconded the motion. Mayor Sanders called for all opposed to say “no”, all in favor say “aye”. Motion carried.
