<u>Minutes:</u> Councilor Kirkland offered a motion to waive the reading of and approve the minutes from November 2, 2023. Councilor Irvin duly seconded the motion. Mayor Pro Tem Roberts called for all in favor say 'aye', all opposed say 'no'. **Mayor Pro Tem Roberts, "Let the** 

record reflect the 'ayes' carry unanimously."

### **Committee Chair Reports:**

Finance: Councilor Irvin offered a motion to approve the bills in the amount of \$78,526.55. Mayor Cochran duly seconded the motion. Highlights on the bills include the payment for the Audit planning in the amount of \$3,000.00. Faucett Road House closing with Hand Arendall \$4,200.00. Mayor Pro Tem Roberts called for all in favor say 'aye', all opposed say 'no'. Mayor Pro Tem Roberts, "Let the record reflect the 'ayes' carry unanimously."

**Enhancements:** Councilor Irvin gave a report about the Veteran's Day Luncheon that took place on November 10, 2023, at The Rock School. Councilor Irvin thanked Three on A String. She also thanked all the Staff that worked.

Councilor Irvin announced the Christmas parade will take place on December 4, 2023, beginning at 6:00 p.m. Councilor Irvin mentioned the registration for float entry is online on the City of Pinson website due by November 24,2023. Councilor Irvin announced that the Grand Marshal for this year will be Caleb Whites Family.

<u>Planning and Zoning-Mayor Cochran offered a motion of Ordinance of Floodplain</u> development. Councilor Irvin duly seconded the motion. Chris Sharit explained the Ordinance and purpose for this ordinance.
