**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT AND EXECUTE  
TAX DEEDS FOR CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY**

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WHEREAS, the City of Pinson is able to purchase certain tax delinquent property from the State of Alabama for nominal processing fees; and


WHEREASE, the City of Pinson finds these properties useful for greenspace and other purposes; and

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF PINSON, ALABAMA** while in regular session on August 21, 2014 at 7 p.m. as follows:

1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to accept and execute the tax deeds for sold-to-state property with no improvements for parcels 9-29-1-266.000, 265.000, 274.000, 268.000, 267.000, for assorted lots in the Brook Crest Addition to Innsbrooke attached to this Resolution.
2. The Mayor is further authorized and directed to accept and execute the tax deeds for sold-to-state property with no improvements for parcels 13-2-4-0-1.000, 13-2-4-0-4.000, 13-2-4-0-20.002, 13-2-1-5-2.000 located near Red Hollow Road, attached to the Resolution.
3. The Mayor is authorized to execute or administer any other item required to fulfill the intent of the resolution and the will of Council.


