**A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE SALE AND REMOVAL OF A  
STRUCTURE AT 6251 LANE STREET**

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
WHEREAS, the City of Pinson is the owner of an unoccupied residential structure located at 6251 Lane Street and known locally as the "Lane-Palmer House" (the "House");

WHEREAS, the House is deemed surplus property, and is not needed for public or municipal purposes;

WHEREAS, § 11-43-56 of the *Code of Alabama* authorizes the City Council to dispose of unneeded personal property; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to dispose of the House in a fair way, bringing a fair salvage price to the City for such items.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF PINSON, ALABAMA** on May 7, 2015 at 7pm , that the Mayor is authorized to solicit and obtain proposals from vendors for the removal of the House from the real property of the City, upon such schedule and parameters as the Mayor deems reasonable and appropriate. proposals should be received by May 21<sup>th</sup>, 2015. Upon obtaining such proposals, the City Council requests that the Mayor provide a report of the same to the City Council, so that it may select the most appropriate and effective proposal for the removal of the House.
