

RESOLUTION NO. 2021- 22

**A RESOLUTION CONCERNING A GRANT OF FUNDS TO THE
PALMERDALE FIRE DISTRICT FOR PREMIUM PAY
FOR ESSENTIAL WORKERS**

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to provide the Palmerdale Fire District (the “District”) with a grant of funds so the District may establish premium pay for certain of its essential workers, as specified in more detail herein;

WHEREAS, premium pay for essential workers, offering additional support to those who have and will bear the greatest health risks because of their service in critical infrastructure sectors, is a qualified expenditure of *Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds*;

WHEREAS, any such premium pay provided by the District shall comply with the rules and regulations of the United States Department of the Treasury for the issuance of premium pay for essential workers pursuant to the *American Rescue Plan Act*;

WHEREAS, any such premium pay provided by the District shall be for prospective services to be rendered in an upcoming pay period, and not for any retroactive or “bonus” pay for services rendered in the past;

WHEREAS, the City is authorized to transfer a portion of the *Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds* to the District, a special-purpose unit of local government” and a third-party employer of essential workers; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that this Resolution has for its objective, a public purpose involving the promotion of public health, safety, morals, security, prosperity, contentment and the general welfare of the community.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PINSON, ALABAMA on August 19, 2021 at 7:00 p.m., as follows:

1. The Mayor is authorized, on behalf of the City, to pay and transfer \$50,000.00 to the District, as a grant of funds so the District may establish premium pay for its essential workers.

2. The City's grant of such funds to the District is expressly conditioned on the District's use of such funds for premium pay in a manner that fully complies with the rules and regulations of the United States Department of the Treasury for the issuance of premium pay for essential workers pursuant to the American Rescue Plan Act. To that end, as a condition of the grant and prior to the release of the funds to the District, the City shall enter into the agreement with the District attached hereto as *Attachment A*.

3. The funds in support of this Resolution are authorized to be expended from the City's allocation of *Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds*.


