RESOLUTION NO. 2021- 24

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE PURCHASE OF A STREET SWEEPER AND DEBRIS VACUUM TRAILER

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to purchase a street sweeper and a debris vacuum trailer for use in the streets and roadways of the City;

WHEREAS, this equipment will help keep the City clean, reducing the debris, litter, trash and other pollutants that are otherwise delivered by stormwater into the City's streams and creeks;

WHEREAS, this equipment has the ability to pick up finely grained particulates (clays, silts, and fine sands), as well as larger items, enhancing its function as a non-structural method of stormwater sediment control;

WHEREAS, the purchase of this equipment is gray infrastructure project related to stormwater, with a water quality benefit, and as such is an eligible program for funding under the *Clean Water State Revolving Fund*, as well as a qualified expenditure of *Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds* (and moreover, much of the area that will be served by the equipment is located in a Qualified Census Tract, which is an area that the federal government has concluded has been disproportionately affected by the pandemic);

WHEREAS, the purchase of this equipment through Sourcewell, a government purchasing cooperative, whose competitive bidding process has been reviewed and approved for use by the State of Alabama Examiners of Public Accounts, pursuant to §41-16-51(a)(16) of the *Code of Alabama*; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that this program has for its objective, a public purpose involving the promotion of public health, safety, morals, security, prosperity, contentment and the general welfare of the community.

- 1. The Mayor is authorized, to cause the City to purchase the following equipment:
 - (a) one 2002 Isuzu NQR Chassis with Victory Mark III Sweeper, for the price of \$160,454.00 from National Auto Fleet Group; and
 - (b) one ODB Xtreme 10, for the price of \$50,500.00 from Sansom Equipment Company.
- 2. The funds in support of this Resolution are authorized to be expended from the City's allocation of *Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds*.
